

CASH IN Code: Pearson Edexcel – IAL & IGCSE

1. Cash in is a code which accumulates the minimum required number of units that gives an overall grade and a certificate in IAL (AS and A levels) & IGCSE.
2. **A candidate will only get a Statement of result without a cash in, and not a certificate of the overall grade**, A cash in code therefore needs to be entered while registering for Edexcel qualification.
3. Ideally the Cash in code is to be applied at the time of registration on SRS as it is free of charge during normal registration stage and will be charged during late-stage period.
4. **AS LEVEL** – Cash in code starts with ‘X’. E.g.: XPH11, XCH11. Candidate must complete the required units/papers required for an AS level of the specified subject.
An AS level cash-in will provide a certificate of the AS level result only.
5. **A level** – Cash in code starts with ‘Y’. EG: YPH11, YCH11 etc. Candidate must complete the required units/papers from both AS and A level to cash in for an A level.
A cash in at A level provides a single certificate combining the AS and A level results.
6. **IGCSE** - Cash in code starts with ‘4X’. EG: 4XCH1, 4XBI1 etc. candidate must complete the required units/papers required.
7. If the candidate requires separate certificates for AS and A level, it is possible by entering AS and A level cash in codes ONLY if they have taken papers in the current series for both AS and A level
8. A cash in code cannot be an individual/standalone entry in any exam session. It must be accompanied by relevant unit/units (Re-sit to improve the grade).
9. If a candidate requires a certificate for any qualification taken in a previous series or after results are released, they must apply for late cash in through CS (using Late cash- in form).
